

# Security Bollards

**Security bollards protect against ram-raid attacks by either preventing the attacking vehicle from penetrating the perimeter or by acting as a deterrent. Bollards prevent vehicle theft by restricting access to areas such as driveways or car park areas. Crash tested bollards and barriers prevent hostile vehicle attacks and ramming attacks, thus protecting pedestrians and infrastructure.**
